



Scholarship Criteria for The Chronicle Cares' Campaign

Purpose: The Chronicle Care's Campaign awards scholarships to My Little Genius' applicants based on demonstrated financial need and an agreement to perform volunteer service with the center to increase early childhood opportunities and community involvement.

Criteria: The families eligible for assistance must enroll a child or multiple children between the ages of 6 weeks and 12 years of age who reside in Forsyth County AND agree to perform one hour of volunteer work per week for the length of their scholarship. Consideration will be given to financial need. Parents should submit a scholarship application on the form provided by My Little Genius'.

Guidelines: Scholarships will be awarded within a years' time and disbursed weekly. Students must continue to be enrolled during the duration of the scholarship timeframe. If a family withdraws their child or children before the end of the scholarship term, the scholarship will end. One member of each family receiving the scholarship shall volunteer a minimum of one hour per week the scholarship is in force.

Amount: Each scholarship awarded will be a maximum of \$2,500 annually.

Deadline: Applications can be turned in until November 1st, 2020.

Renewal process: This scholarship is not renewable. Only families that have paid their registration fee are eligible to apply. Previous scholarship recipients cannot re-apply.
